#### he CAB

and others, contend that the way that the current management style of the current CAB is utdated. It used to be that power was had by controlling the information process. That style is utdated and is contrary to the management style required by a community-based radio, which reds an open and transparent in all aspects of operation in order to gain community wide support.

te current membership is not representative of the community that the radio serves. They board embership could best be described as President Garcia's friends, who will not question what he ys. and Francisco Rios' work associates. Some of the old members, including the President, we been on the CAB for a long time without regard to term limits and the new members are from 21's group receiving grants. All to strengthen the current Radio administration, not to bring new las.

le process with which the new members were placed on the CAB is also suspect. There was no nmunity announcement for new members, rather the members were chosen from work partners, ould have applied to serve on the CAB if I had been informed and I would certainly have tested the appointment of an L&I Investigator to the CAB!

T current CAB function is limited to protect the current radio administration without regard to at the future of Radio KDNA should be.

To results of the recent membership drive is indicative of a disconnect between the radio and the imunity and the current administration is to blame.

at also here to report to the CAB regarding the current management of Radio KDNA by claco Rios and his overreach of authority, which is causing a hostile work environment within

The Sea-Mar Board is providing very little direction on the transition of KDNA istration after Juan Ozuna retired and, after investigation, it appears that Sea-Mar was ced to continue as always by appointing Francisco Rios as a Group Leader, rather than Manager because that would place him out of the union. Francisco Rios has limited powers, is acting outside of his authority, he is acting as if he was the Radio Manager. He presents but F f as the Radio Manager in writing and he did not correct the program announcer on a major radio station when he was identified as the Radio Manager. We ntend that Francisco Rios has showed to be biased in his actions and is not qualified to be NA Radio Manager.
